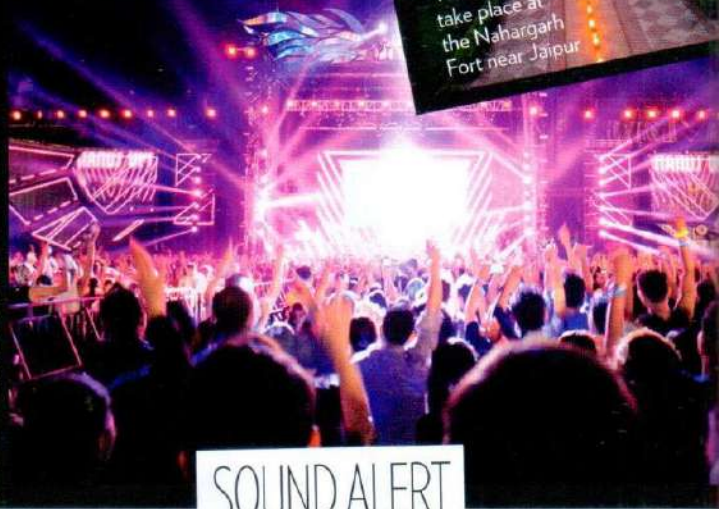

Rajasthan's newest festival brings together art, film, theatre and performances by big-ticket acts like Ziggy Marley

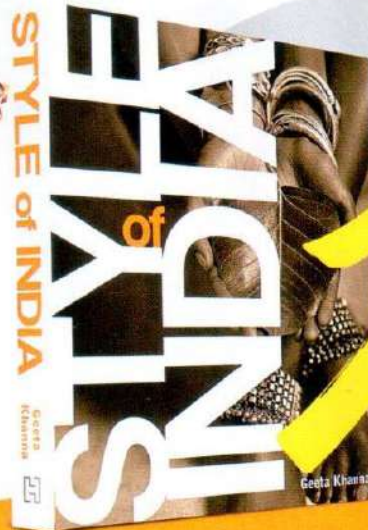
India's favourite electronic duo Midival Punditz find a spot next to the sonorous rhythm of Zila Khan, while the classical beats of Zakir Hussain merge with Ziggy Marley's reggae vibe. Poetry readings by Naseeruddin Shah and Rajasthani folk theatre share stage space, even as wildlife conservation initiatives are

offset by hot-air balloon rides and a hedonistic food bazaar. The **Ranthambore Festival**, a three-day multi-disciplinary cultural festival (January 27-29), is the latest offering from Abhimanyu Alsisar, one of the organisers of the Magnetic Fields festival. Slated to take place at Nahargarh Fort, a fortress-turned-hotel on

the fringes of the Ranthambore National Park, the festival will feature a series of open-air amphitheatre gigs as well as camp sites. The best part? It's free for all, though smaller venue shows will be ticketed. [Nahargarh.com](http://Nahargarh.com)
